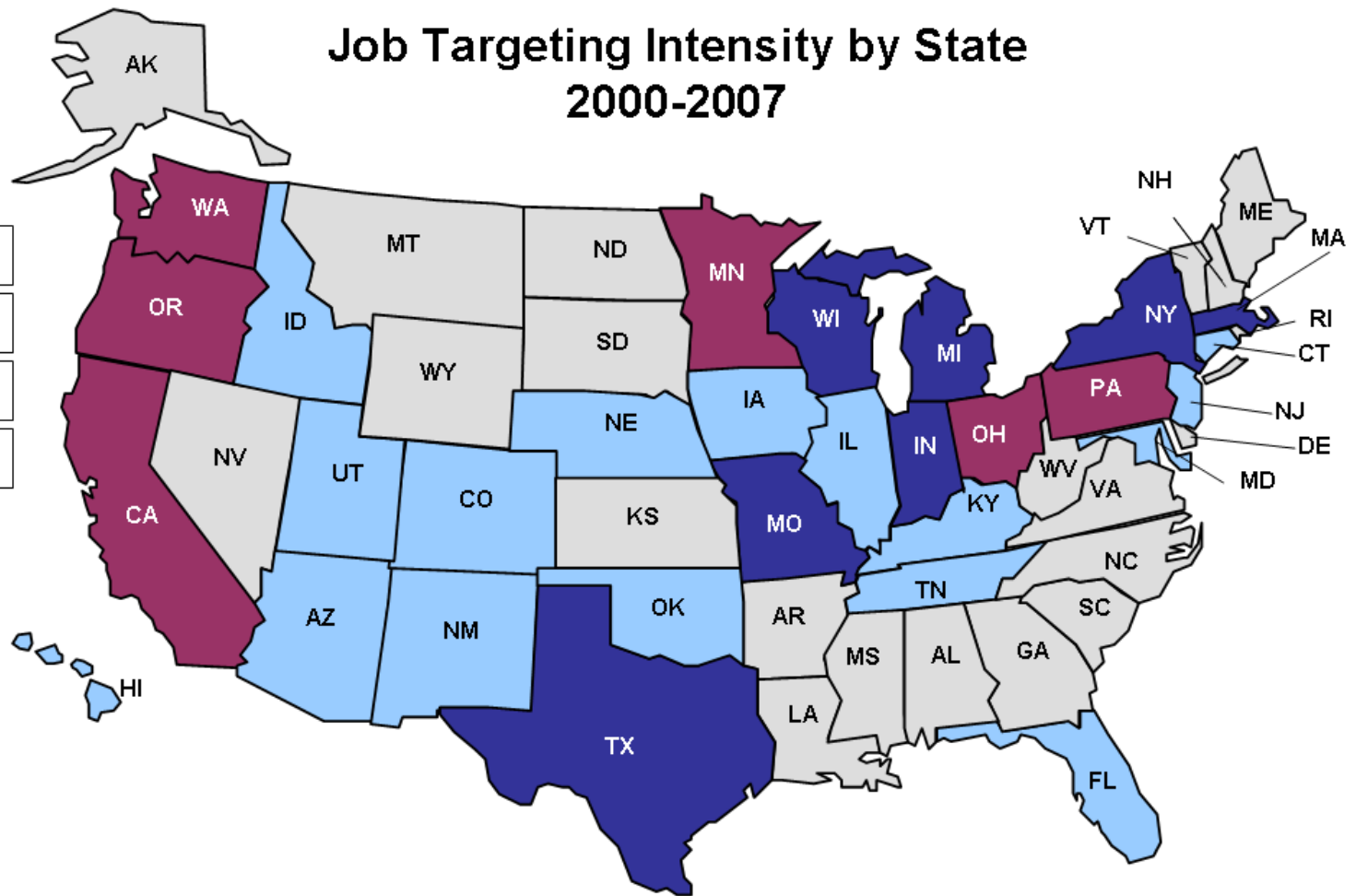
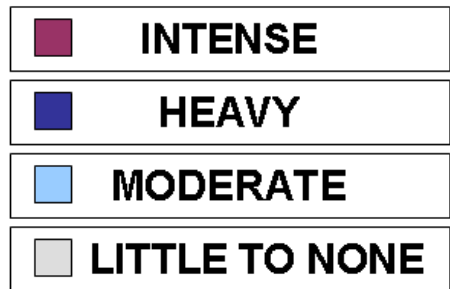

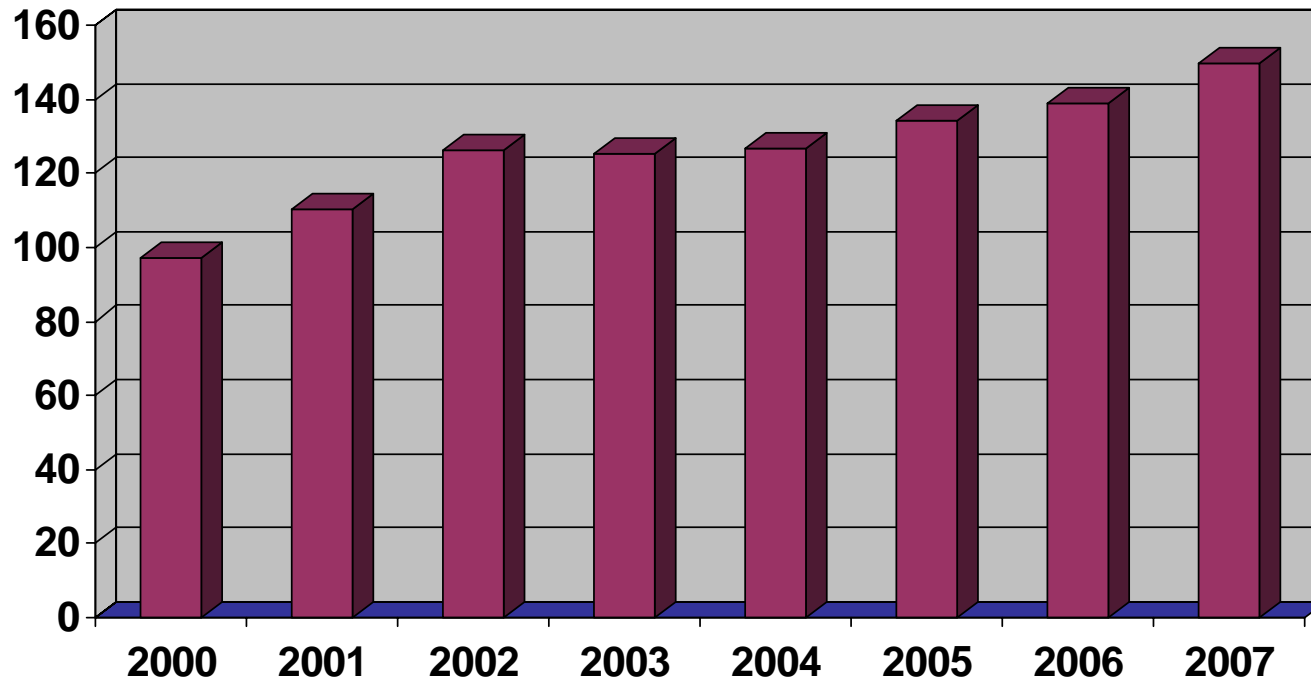


# Job Targeting Intensity Nationwide

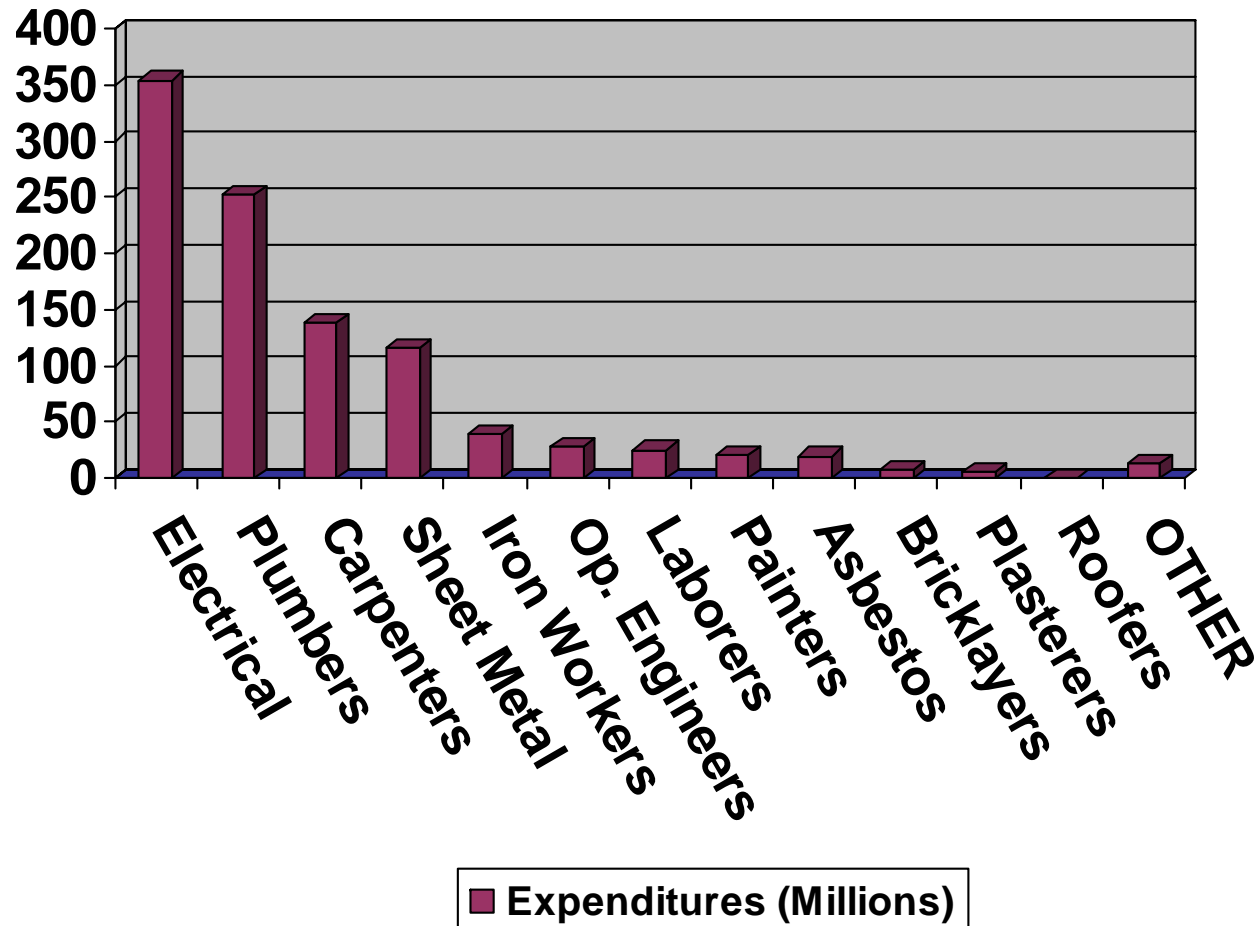

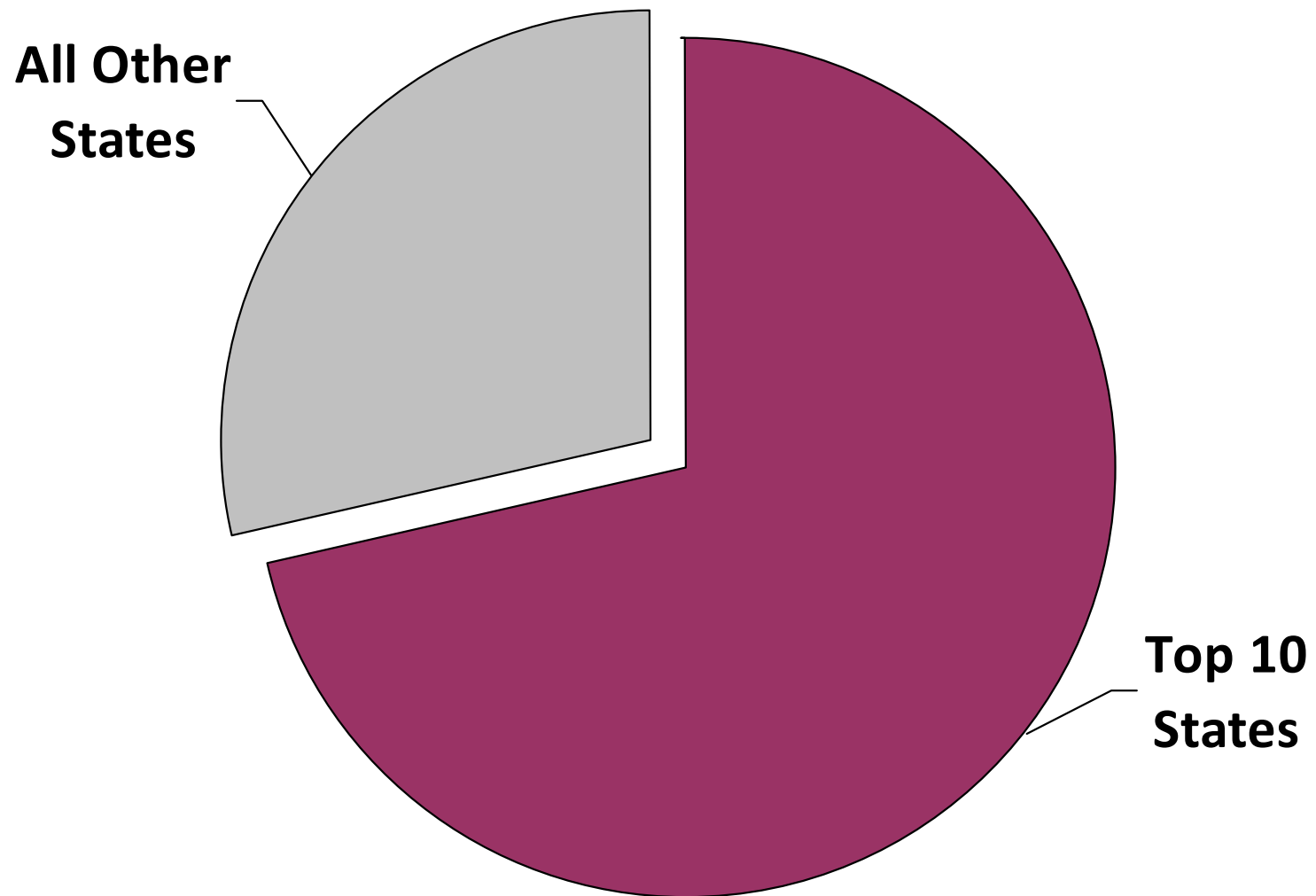

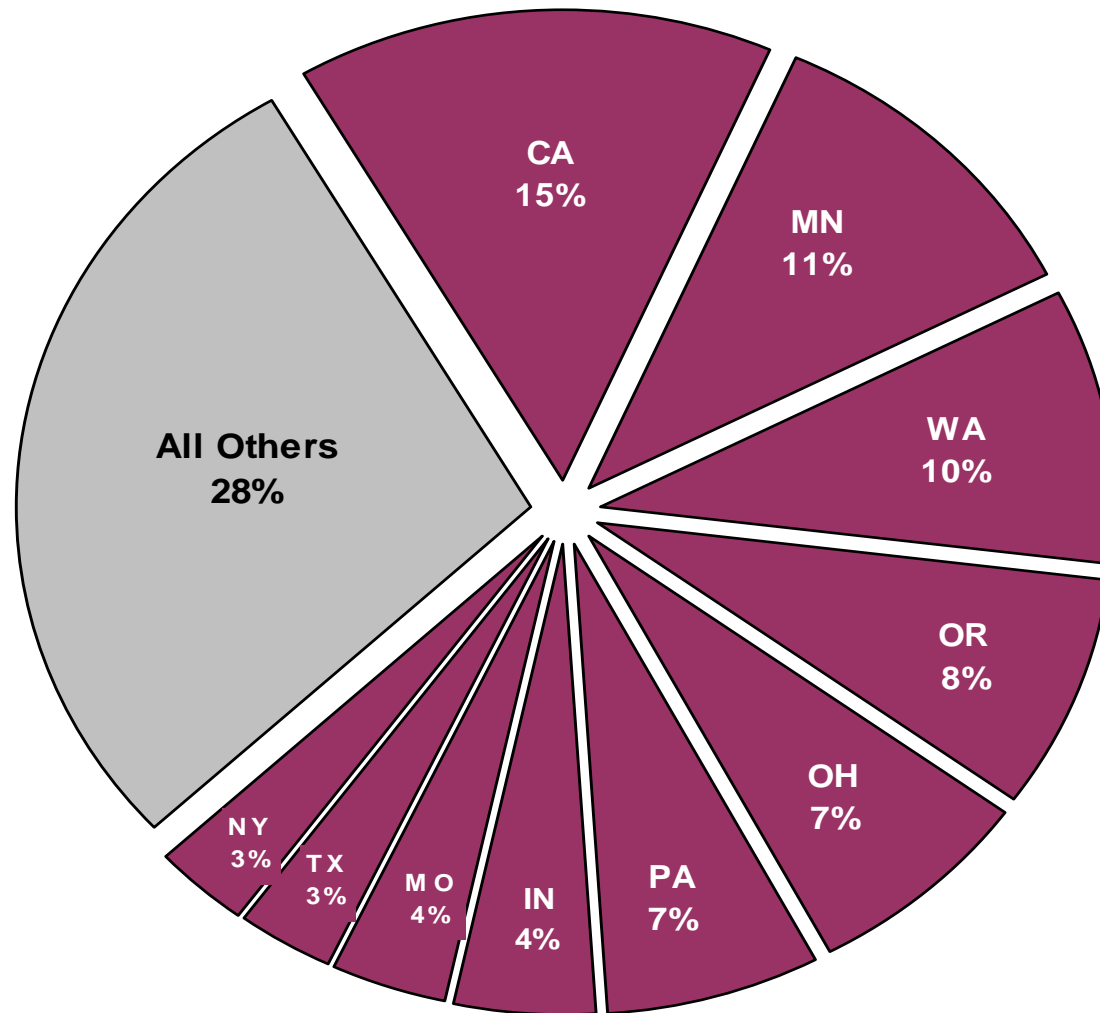
# Top Ten Job Targeting States 2000-2007



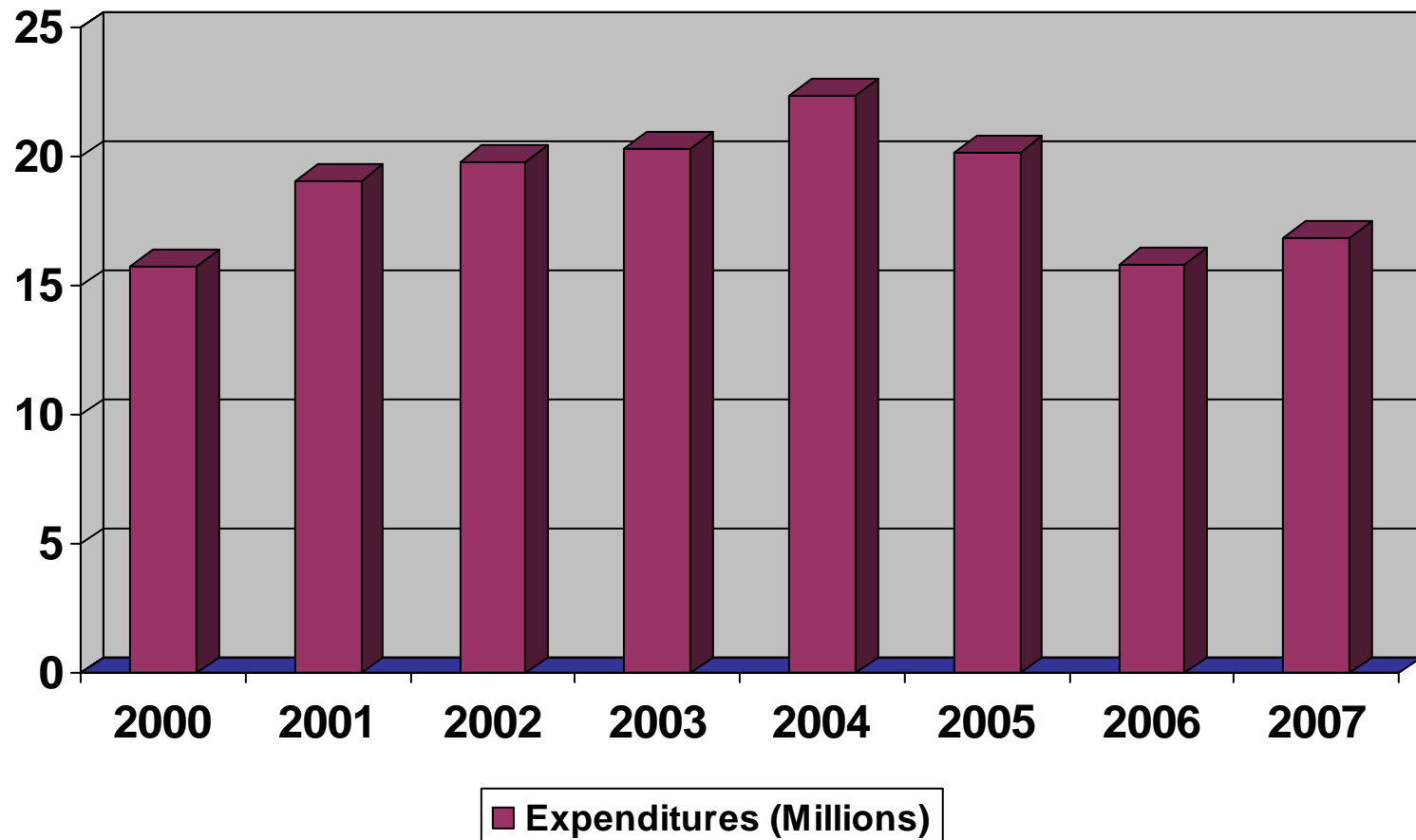
# Job Targeting Disbursements for Top Ten States 2000-2007

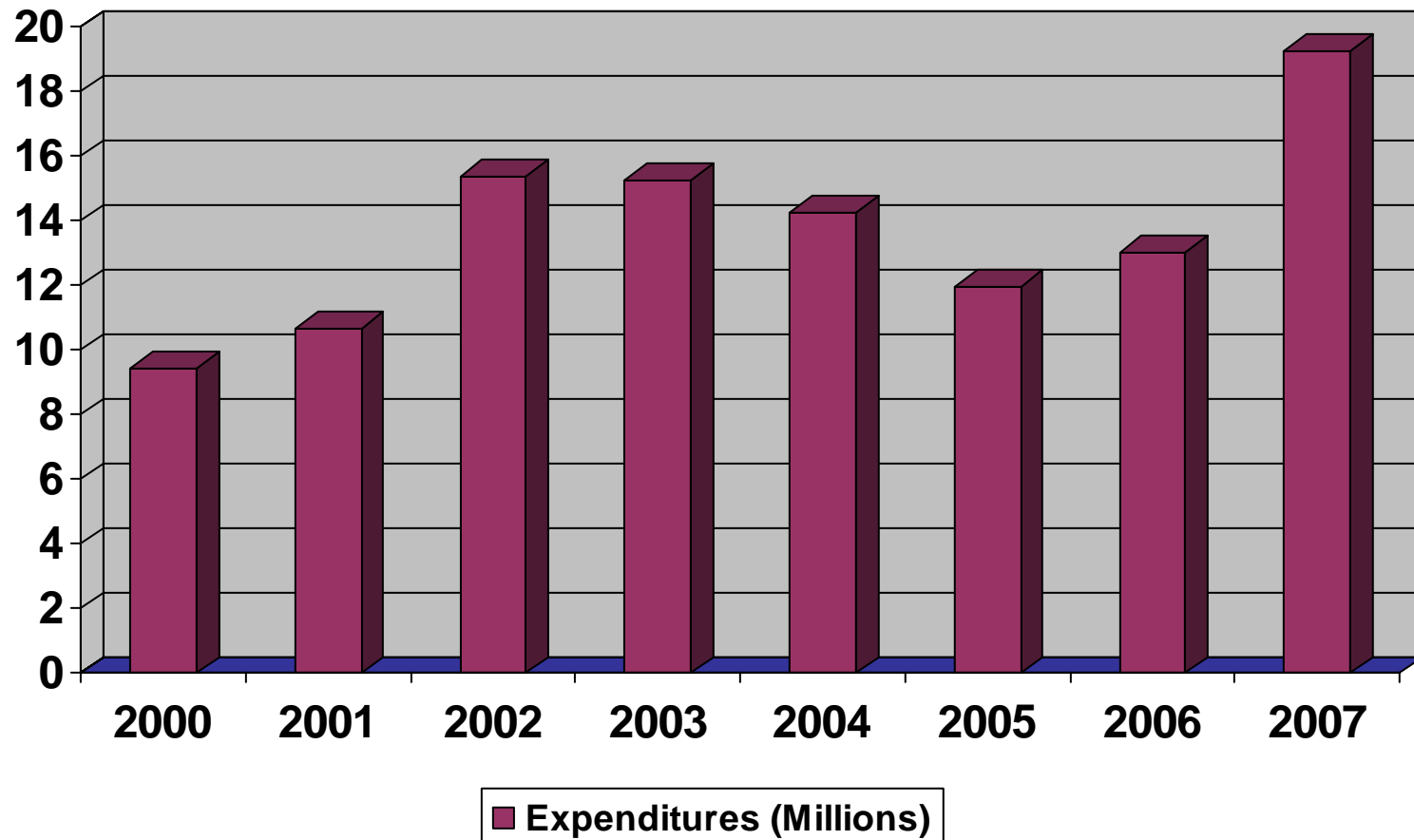


# California Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007



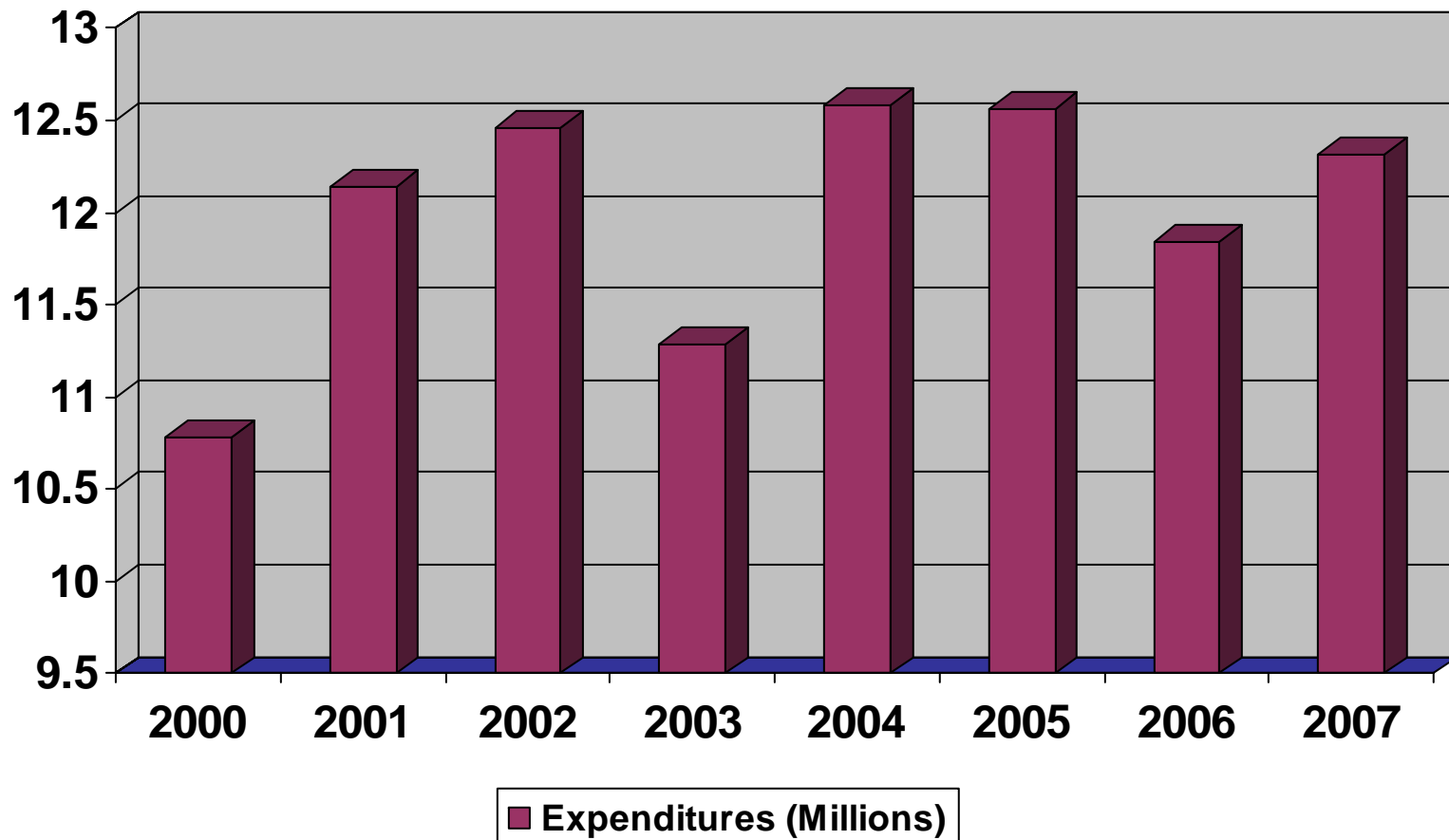

# Minnesota Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007



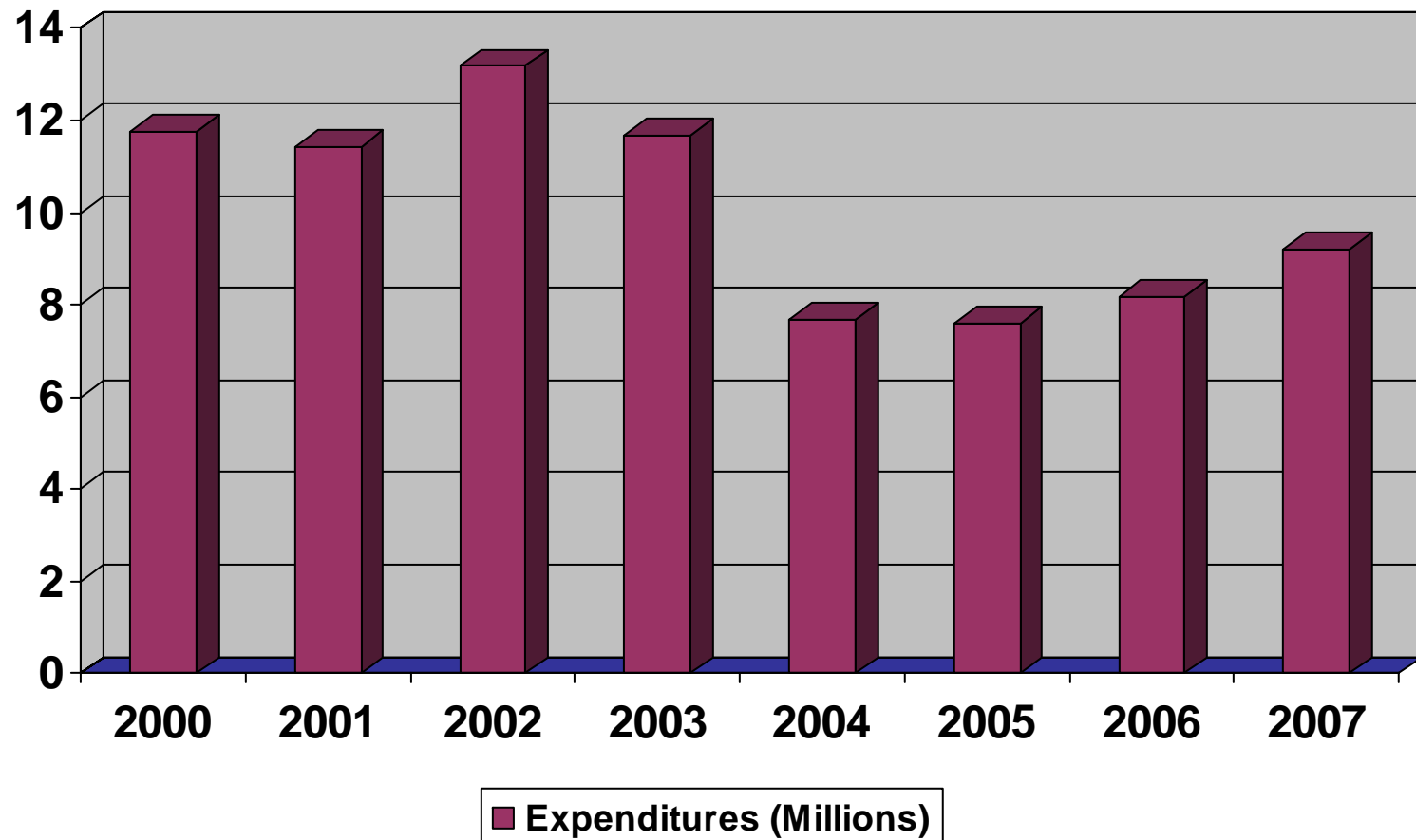

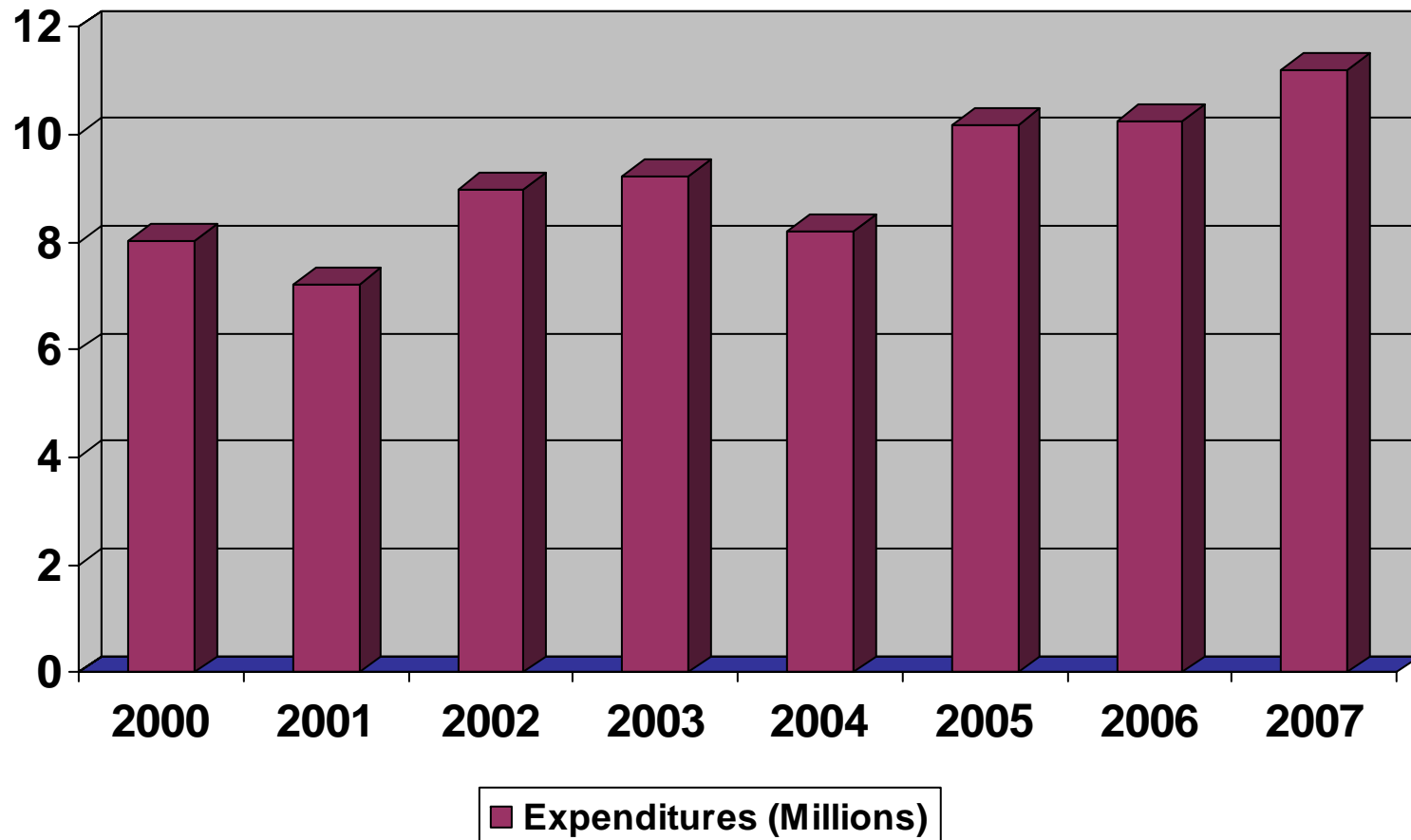
# Oregon Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007

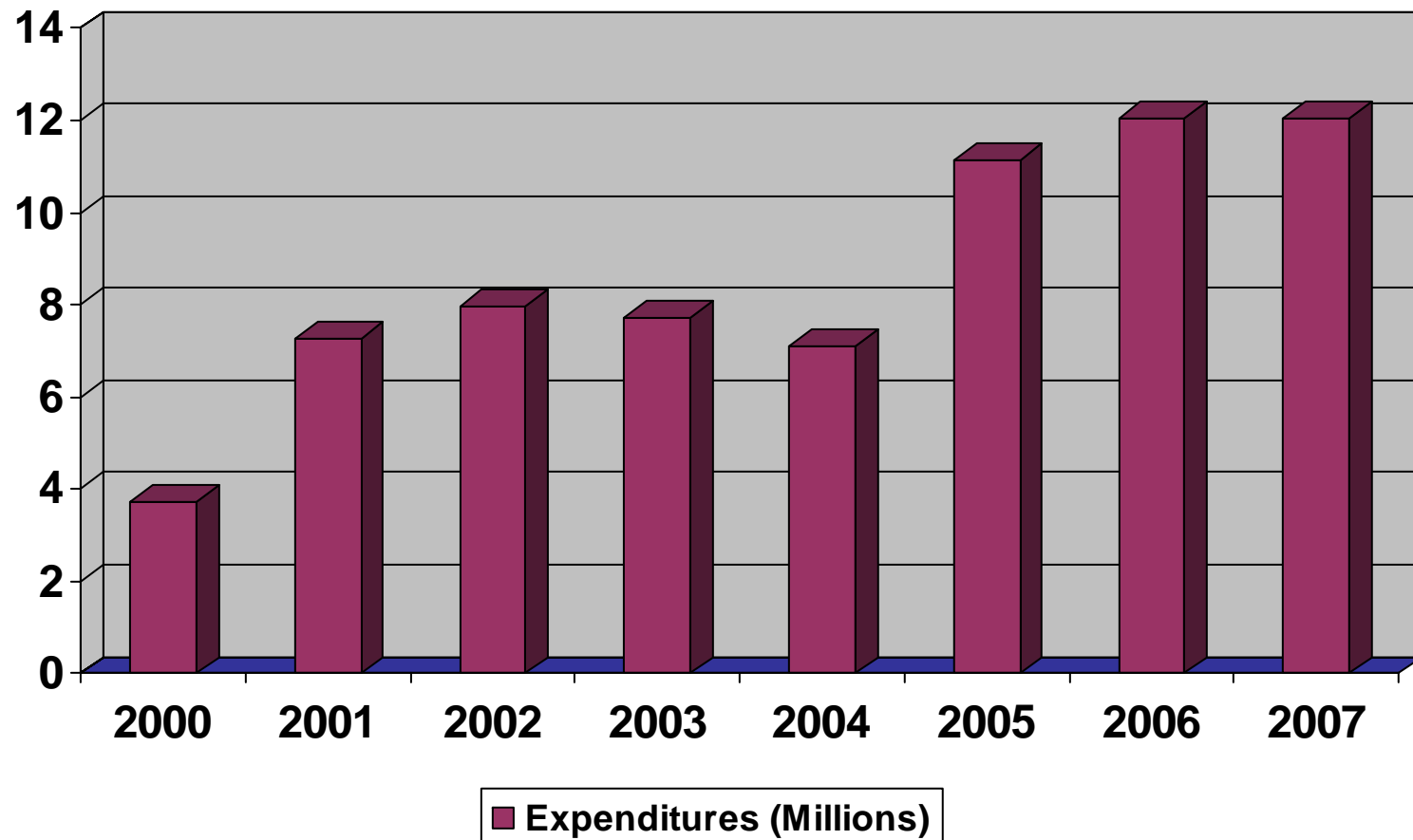


# Ohio Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007



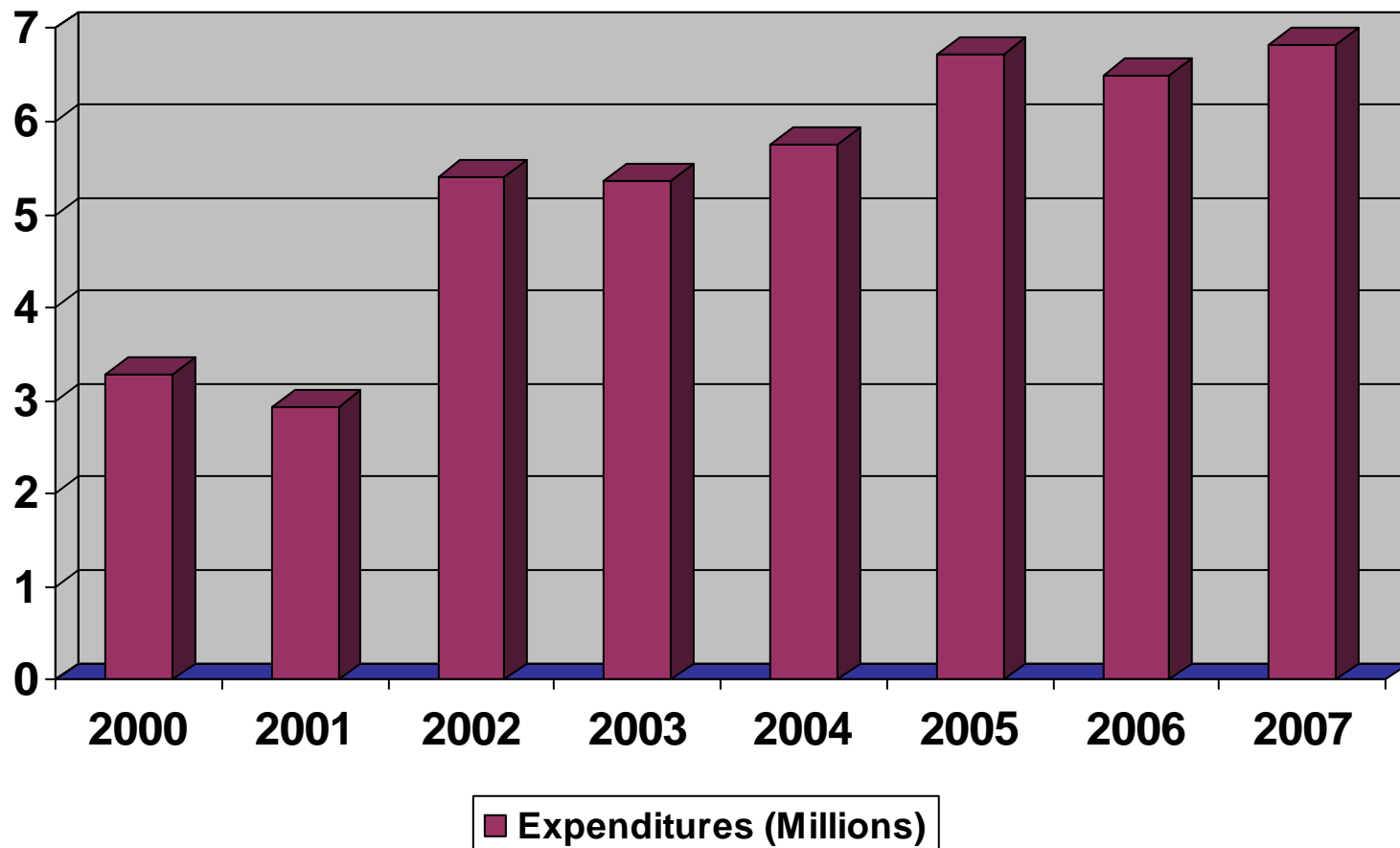

# Pennsylvania Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007



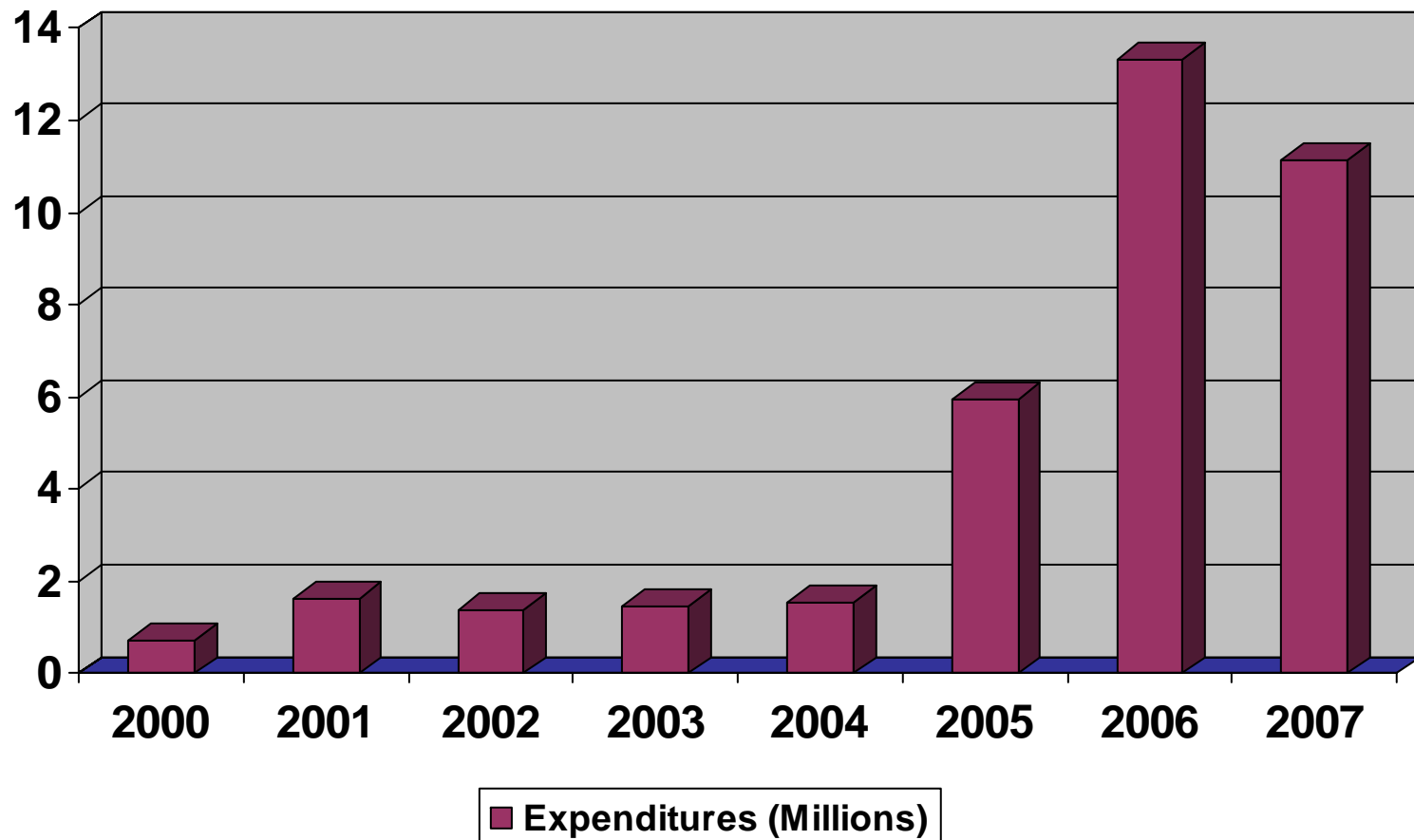

# Indiana Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007



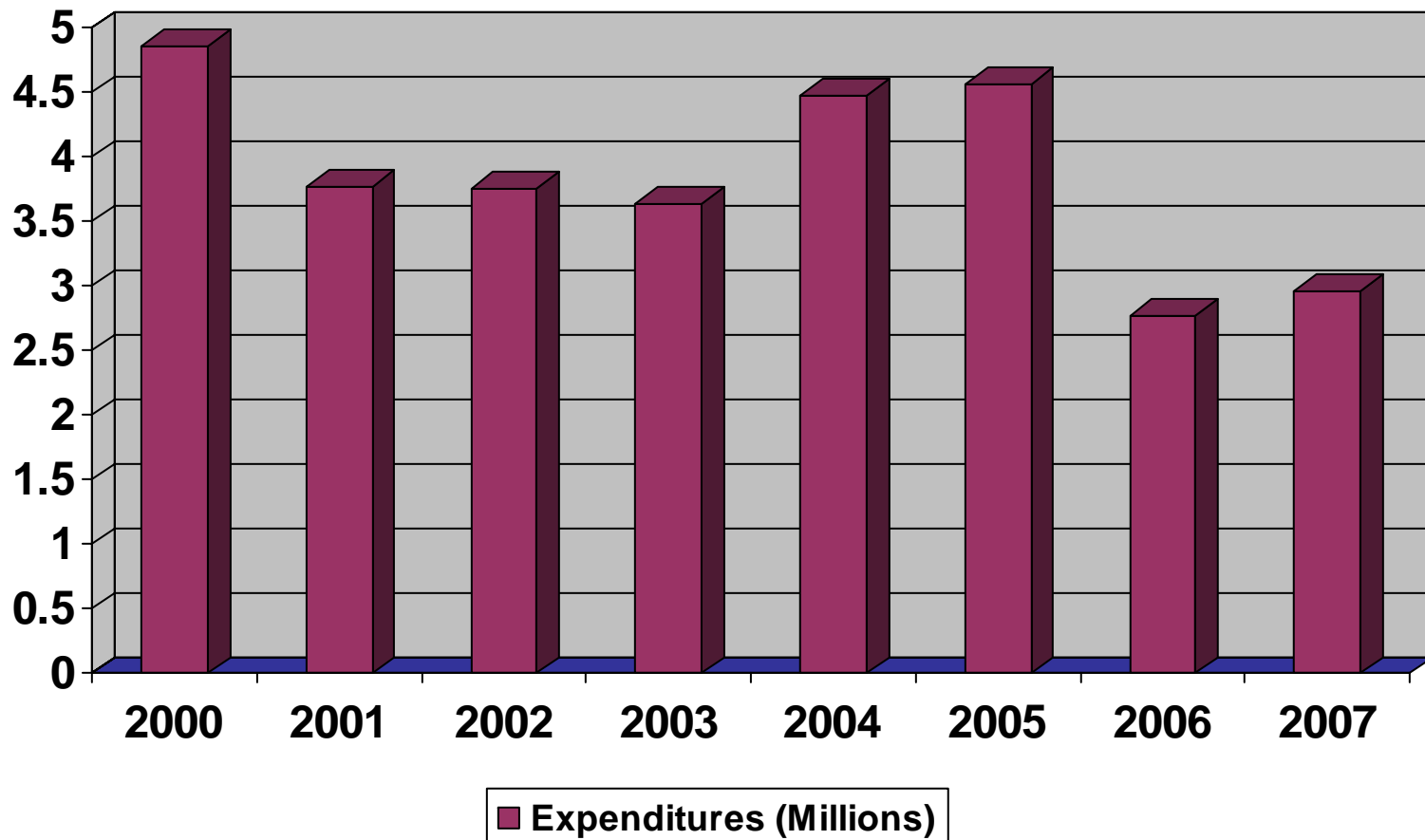

# Missouri Job Targeting Expenditures 2000-2007



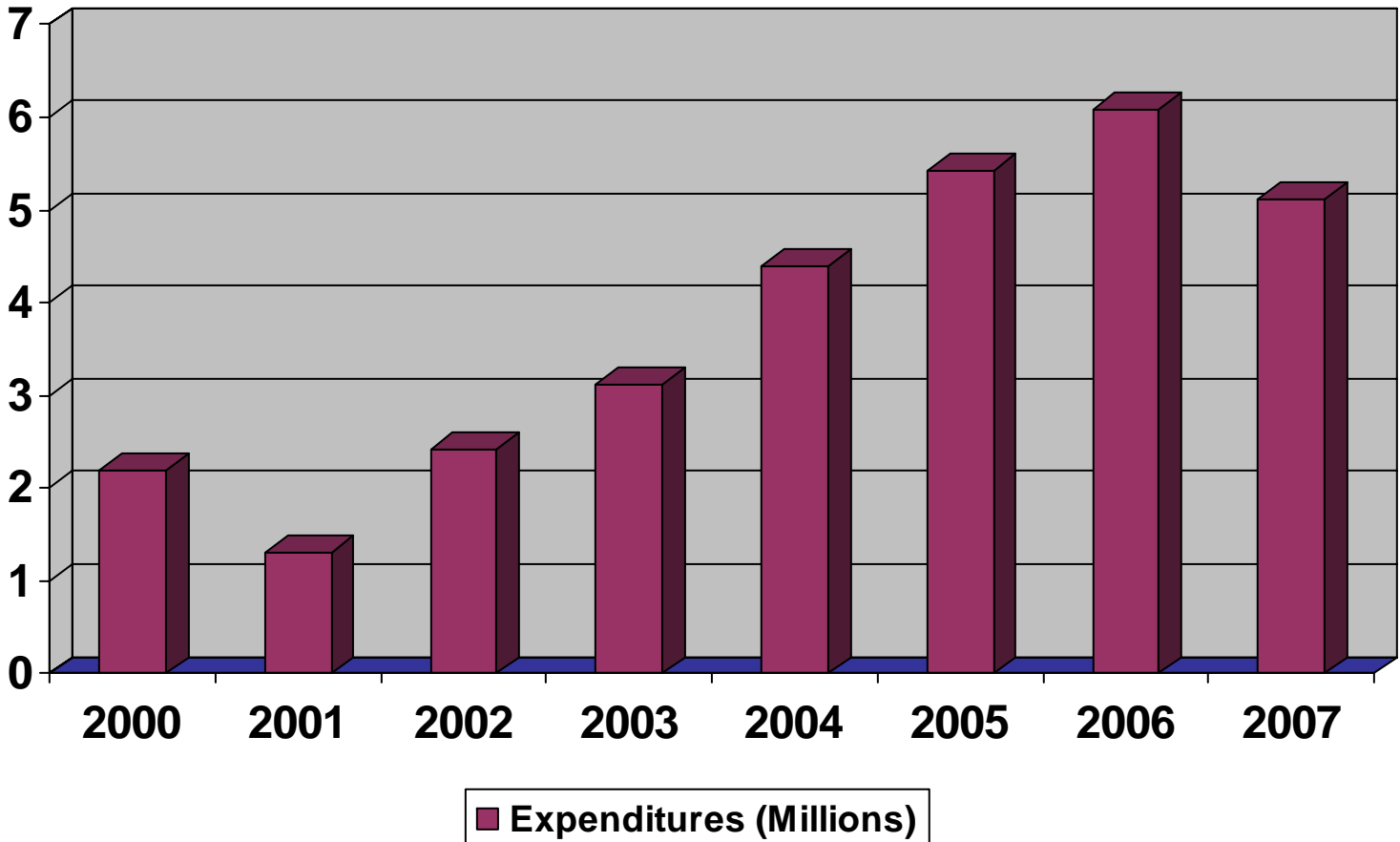
