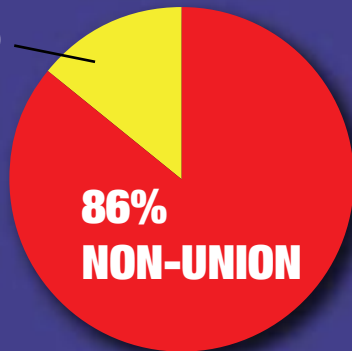
What are L.A. Union-Boss Politics Doing in Ventura County?
